UTILITY RATES

To meet increasing demands for utility services, an upgrade in the utility infrastructure will be required in the future. Expansion of the existing Wastewater Treatment Plant and additional lines to loop the Municipal Water System are among those upgrades. To fund these upgrades it is necessary to increase utility reserve funds. To accomplish this it is necessary to increase utility rates beginning January 1, 2015.

Rates for water will be adjusted annually beginning January 1, 2015 through January 1, 2019 as set forth in Table 1 below.
